Timeline for Envoys

Monthly tasks: Complete the following during the last week or the first of each month.

- Share a section of that month's Envoy News with your congregation
- Consider choosing an Action Item from the Envoy News ("Time to Act" section) to plan for the next month at your congregation (Ex: Collecting petition signatures; holding a fundraiser for a suggested NGO; holding a film screening and discussion)
- Consider commemorating any of the holidays that month at your congregation. Some ways to do so include:
 - o Holding an event along the theme or in commemoration of that day
 - o Tabling during coffee hour to collect petition signatures for that issue
 - Making an announcement during the service or ensuring that the holiday is worked into the service thematically
 - o Write about the holiday in your congregation's newsletter

JULY

Main Focus: Set goals/begin plans for UU-UNO Envoy Action in the coming year

- Get your Envoy Team together and start to sketch out a plan of action for what you hope to do & accomplish throughout the coming year.
 - o Discuss your ideas with the congregation's DREs, youth advisors, social justice team, etc. and consider how to work together to get more people involved
 - Look over the UN Sunday Packet with your team and begin the UN Sunday planning process (Detailed UN Sunday planning schedule included in Packet!)
- Share information on applying to join the Spring Seminar Planning Committee with congregation (Applications are due during the summer!)

AUGUST

Main Focus: Begin Planning UN Sunday, and other activities for the year

- Reconvene with UN Sunday Service Planning Team and check in on progress
- Continue reaching out to speakers, musicians, etc. for the UN Sunday service as needed.
- Hold planning meeting for a fundraiser to send a delegation to Spring Seminar
 - Select location and type of fundraiser (ex: bake sale; potluck dinner; coffeehouse)
 - Develop list of people to reach out to where needed (ex: Youth group, Social Justice Committees, DREs, Advisors)
- August Holidays:
 - O Aug 6th: Hiroshima Day
 - Aug 9th: International Day of the World's Indigenous Peoples
 - o Aug 12th: International Youth Day

- o Aug 19th: World Humanitarian Day

SEPTEMBER

Main Focus: Raise awareness about UN Sunday and Spring Seminar

- Reconvene with UN Sunday planning team to finalize details and start promoting the service
- Continue planning for a fundraiser to send a delegation to Spring Seminar
 - Finalize details, including date/location of fundraiser, cost of tickets/goods, outside parties assisting with fundraiser.
 - o Develop plan for advertising the fundraiser, and begin advertising it to congregation members.

Main Focus: UN Sunday service

- Hold your UN Sunday Service
 - Hold a collection plate for the UU-UNO if possible work with the treasurer to track the individuals who donated to the UU-UNO at Supporter levels during the collection (this will be helpful for achieving Blue Ribbon status!)
 - o During the three weeks prior, continuously advertise the UN Sunday service to your congregation via social media, coffee hour tabling, flyers, or announcements during services.
 - During the week after the UN Sunday Service, post photos of the service on your congregation's website or social media.

Main Focus: Send in UN Sunday Report, Fundraise to attend Spring Seminar

- Submit UN Sunday report, photos of your UN Sunday service, and your annual plate collection to the UU-UNO. Share about the service on UN Sunday Services online map.
 - o If you can, get permission from the congregation for the service photos to be used by the UU-UNO.
- Establish a plan for submitting your UN Sunday sermon for the Dana Greeley Award
- Hold your fundraiser to send a delegation to the UU-UNO Spring Seminar
 - Ouring the two weeks prior, be sure to continuously advertise the fundraiser to your congregation via social media, coffee hour tabling, flyers, or announcements during services.

November Holidays:

 - o Make announcements during service, and share with different committees
 - Visit youth group to inform them of Spring Seminar

- Check the date for your UUA District or Regional assembly (most are between March May). If you can, see about hosting a UU-UNO-related event/workshop or an exhibit table at the assembly. Contact UU-UNO for help with this.

JANUARY

Main focus: Greeley Award Deadline is coming up

- Visit youth group again to continue publicizing Spring Seminar and the UU-UNO Summer Internship Program.
- Mid-January: Deadline for Spring Seminar scholarship applications
- Follow up with ideas/plans for participation in your District/Regional Assembly
- Last call for submissions! Submit your UN Sunday sermon by the end of the month for the Dana Greeley Award if you haven't already (Deadline is Feb. 1)

 - o Jan 27th: International Day of Commemoration in Memory of the Victims of the Holocaust

FEBRUARY

Main Focus: Publicize Spring Seminar Registration

- **February 1**st: Final day to submit sermons for the Dana Greeley Sermon Award.
- Continue publicizing the UU-UNO Spring Seminar to the congregation and youth group.
- Check in with UU-UNO to see where your congregation stands regarding qualifications to be a Blue Ribbon Congregation. See what more you need to do before the March 31 deadline.

Main Focus: Blue Ribbon requirements

- Look out for the opening of UUA General Assembly registration.

- Get ready for your District or Regional assembly and/or Spring Seminar!
- March 31st: Blue Ribbon Qualifications Deadline: Ensure that your congregation has fulfilled all of the Blue Ribbon Award requirements.

- If unable to attend Spring Seminar, consider hosting a UU-UNO event in your community (invite local congregations!) Watch the live-stream of the Seminar Theme Panel at UN Headquarters and provide time for discussion afterwards.
- Lobby to put a line for the UU-UNO in your congregation's budget.
 - o Meet with your congregation's board and social justice team to discuss the feasibility of this.
 - o (If appropriate) Hold a table during coffee hour to collect signatures in support.
- Look out for the Dana Greeley Award Winner announcement!

- (Canadian congregations, on even years) Attend CUC's national conference and touch base with the UU-UNO at CUC by stopping by our booth and attending our Envoy gathering(s)!

 - o May 3rd: World Press Freedom Day
 - May 15th: International Day of Families
- May 21st: World Day for Cultural Diversity for Dialogue and Development

JUNE

Main Focus: Reflect on the past year and consider ideas for next year

- Meet with your Envoy team and other involved persons to recap successes for the year and how to improve/be more effective.
- (US congregations) Attend UUA General Assembly, and touch base with the UU-UNO at GA by stopping by our booth and attending our Envoy gathering(s)!
- Share information on applying to join the Spring Seminar Planning Committee with congregation (Applications are due during the summer)
- June Holidays:

 - O June 12th: World Day Against Child Labour
- o June 20th: World Refugee Day
