

**Proposed Bylaw Amendments for the PNWD Annual Meeting, 2021**

This year, the Pacific Northwest is taking a significant step on the road of regionalization, as we are advising our member congregations to vote to dissolve the District. However, our Bylaws give us no pathway for dissolution or even evolution of this organization! So, at our Annual Meeting on May 16, we are asking you to vote to on this Bylaw Amendment, which outlines how the Pacific Northwest District can dissolve:

Article XI – DISSOLUTION

Section 1. the PNWD can be dissolved using one of the following procedures:

- (a) a majority vote of the membership voting at an annual or special meeting, declaring the PNWD dissolved
- (b) a unanimous vote of the remaining Directors at a regular or special board meeting, declaring the PNWD dissolved

Section 2. Upon dissolution, all former member Congregations and Associate Organizations of the PNWD shall be notified by the Secretary of dissolution containing the date of dissolution.
